Instructions

Check the circle that best describes how often your child shows each behavior. Totals within each category may help highlight sensory areas that may be more challenging or noticeable for your child.

Important Things to Know

- This questionnaire is an informal screening tool designed to gather parent observations. It is not a standardized or diagnostic assessment.
- The purpose of this tool is to support understanding, not to label or diagnose.
- Results reflect your observations at one point in time. Children's behaviors can change based on age, stress, routines, and environment.
- Responses may look different at home compared to school or other settings.
- Use the results to help guide next steps or conversations with teachers, therapists, or other professionals if questions or concerns arise.

Interpretation

This questionnaire is designed to help you notice patterns in your child's sensory experiences, emotional regulation, and behavior at home. There is no "good" or "bad" score. Every child responds differently to their world.

- You notice challenges across multiple categories.
- You have ongoing concerns or questions about your child's development or well-being.
